We would like to organize the Conference in a new, innovative way, highlighting the pragmatic side of medical librarian profession. Our goal is also to involve all libraries working under the auspices of the Conference of Directors of Medical Libraries (Konferencja Dyrektorów Bibliotek Akademickich Uczelni Medycznych) in active participation in this special event. We intend to put emphasis on workshops. During those we are going to cooperate in groups, trying to work out new solutions, scenarios and approaches concerning our everyday professional challenges. We plan to host approximately 120 participants. We hope that at least five representatives from each of the bigger medical libraries will take part in the Conference. We also address our invitation to libraries of scientific institutes involved in the subjects of health care and libraries of all institutions of higher education that train medical staff and conduct research in the fields of medicine and health sciences.
